

Resumption of the production activities of the Dieu Merci plant


Auplata Mining Group - AMG (Euronext Growth - FR0013410370 - ALAMG) is pleased to announce the resumption of production of its plant on the site of Dieu Merci.

With the improvement of the sanitary situation, the logistic supply channels are gradually returning to normal, which has allowed AMG to bring the equipment and supplies necessary to restart production.

Since the resumption of activity at the Dieu Merci site at the beginning of July 2020, which had been stopped since April 7, 2020 due to the health crisis, AMG teams have refurbished a "Bergeaud" brand ball mill so that production can resume as quickly as possible. It enables the ore to be crushed to a grain size of less than 0.3 mm, thus increasing gold recovery and consequently the profitability of the plant. This mill, which has a processing capacity of 100 tons per day, is already installed.

In addition, AMG's teams are finalizing the refurbishment of two "Neyrtec" ball mills, which will allow a significant increase in capacity and an improvement in granulometry by operating with hydrocyclones. Once installed, these two mills should allow a gradual increase in the processing capacity of the cuttings to 200 tons per day.

These refurbishments were carried out while awaiting the installation of the "Funvesa" ball mill with Peruvian hydrocyclones. Ordered more than 5 months ago, the latter only arrived in French Guyana at the end of August, delayed by the health crisis. This crusher and these hydrocyclones are currently being transported to the site; once installed to replace the other crushers, it will allow the nominal treatment capacity of the plant to reach 300 tons per day.
